



Seizing Typhoon Window: 100-ton Heavy Cargo Safely Shipped from Qingdao to Hitachi Port

Recently, successive typhoons Hongxia, Dolphin and Chan-hom brought harsh offshore operating conditions.

Working around-the-clock, the project team closely monitored weather updates and accurately analyzed typhoon tracks to seize the short favorable navigation window. The vessel departed Qingdao Port and braved rough sea conditions to safely deliver the 100-ton heavy-lift cargo to Hitachi Port, Japan, successfully completing this cross-border heavy-lift shipping mission.

This operation demonstrates the team's capability to deliver heavy-lift marine logistics under complex weather conditions. Going forward, the team will maintain strict safety standards to guarantee performance of subsequent equipment shipments.
